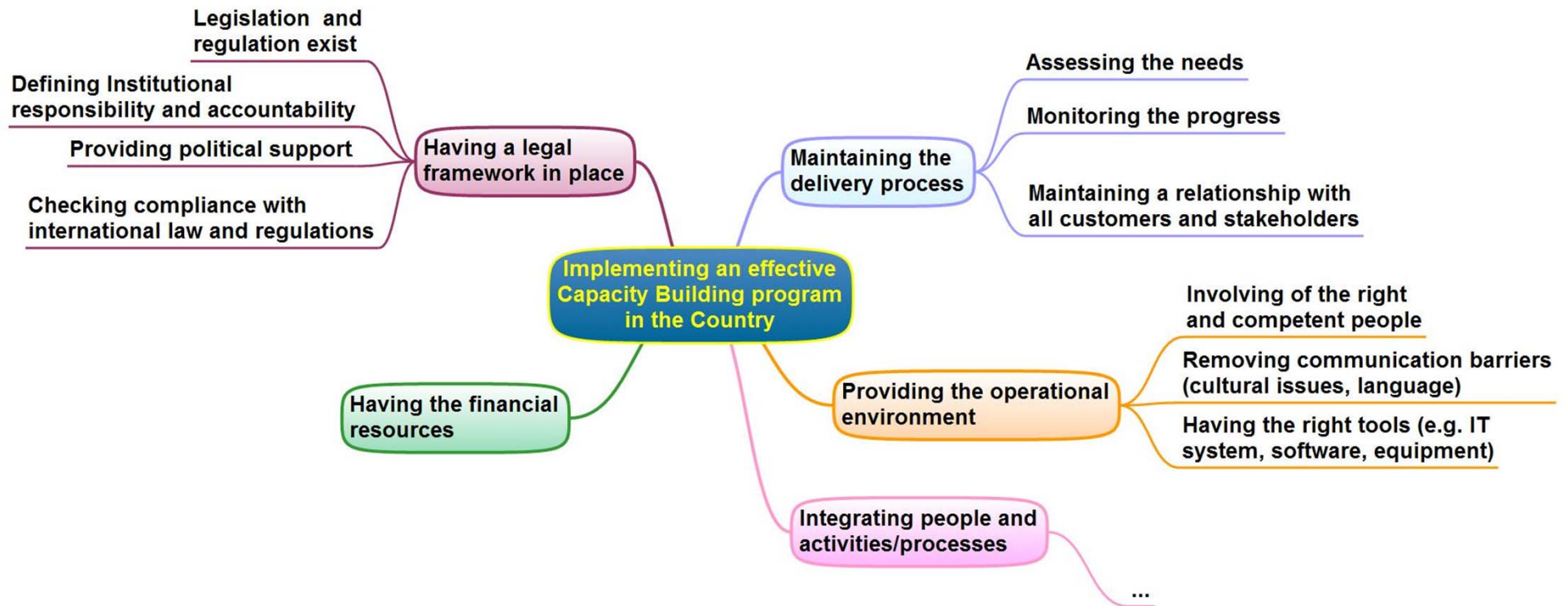

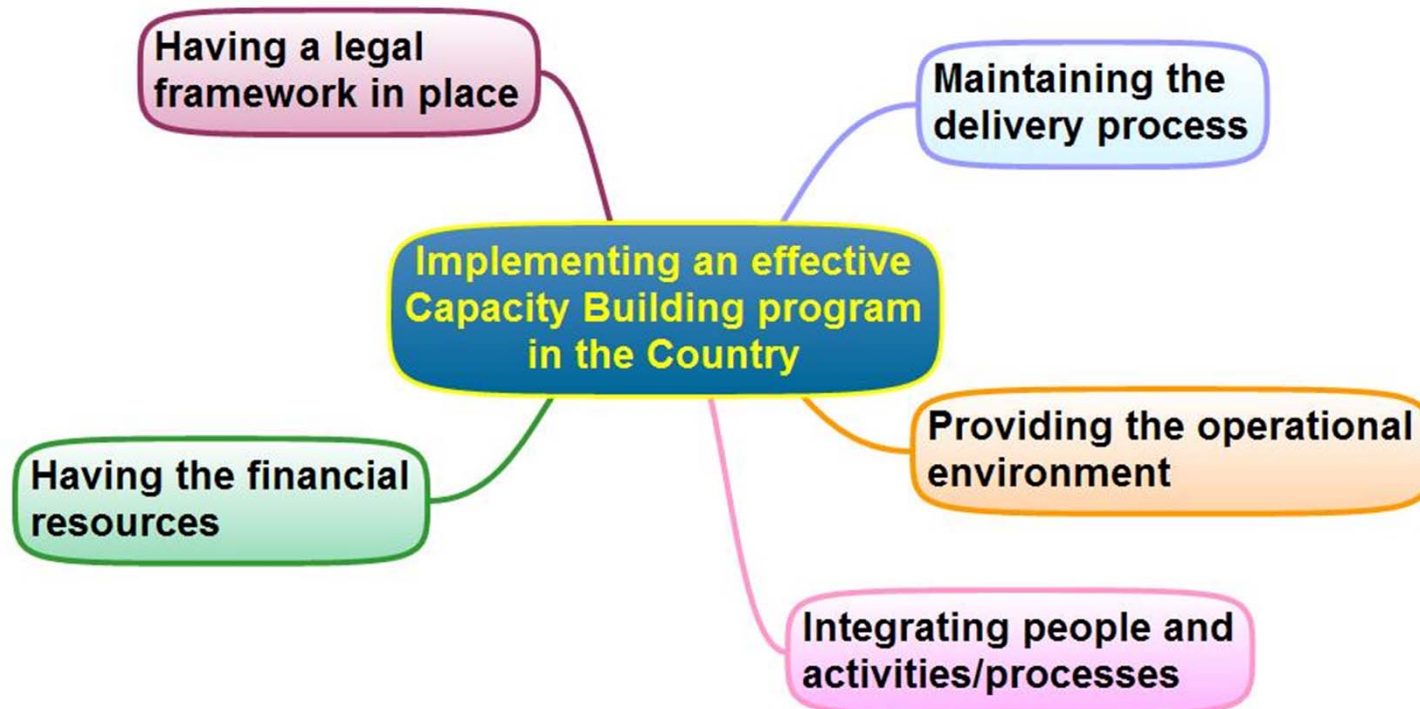

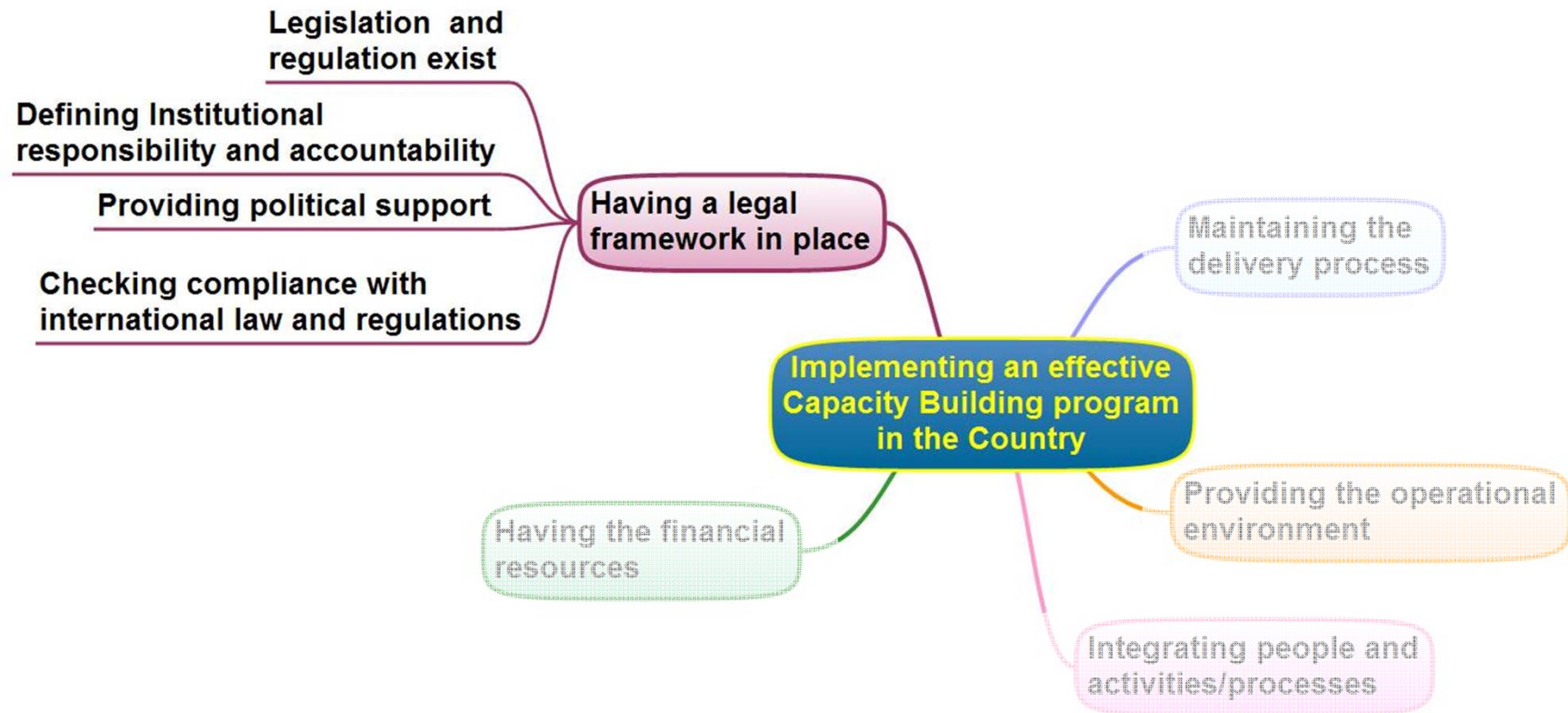

IMPLEMENTING AN EFFECTIVE CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM

- ▲ Providing the operational environment
- ▲ Integrating people and activities/processes
- ▲ Having the financial resources
- ▲ Having a legal framework in place
- ▲ Maintaining the delivery process





HAVING A LEGAL FRAMEWORK IN PLACE

- ▲ Legislation and regulation exist
- ▲ Defining Institutional responsibility and accountability
- ▲ Providing political support
- ▲ Checking compliance with international law and regulations





MAINTAINING THE DELIVERY PROCESS

- ▲ Assessing the needs
- ▲ Monitoring the progress
- ▲ Maintaining a relationship with all customers and stakeholders





PROVIDING THE OPERATIONAL ENVIRONMENT

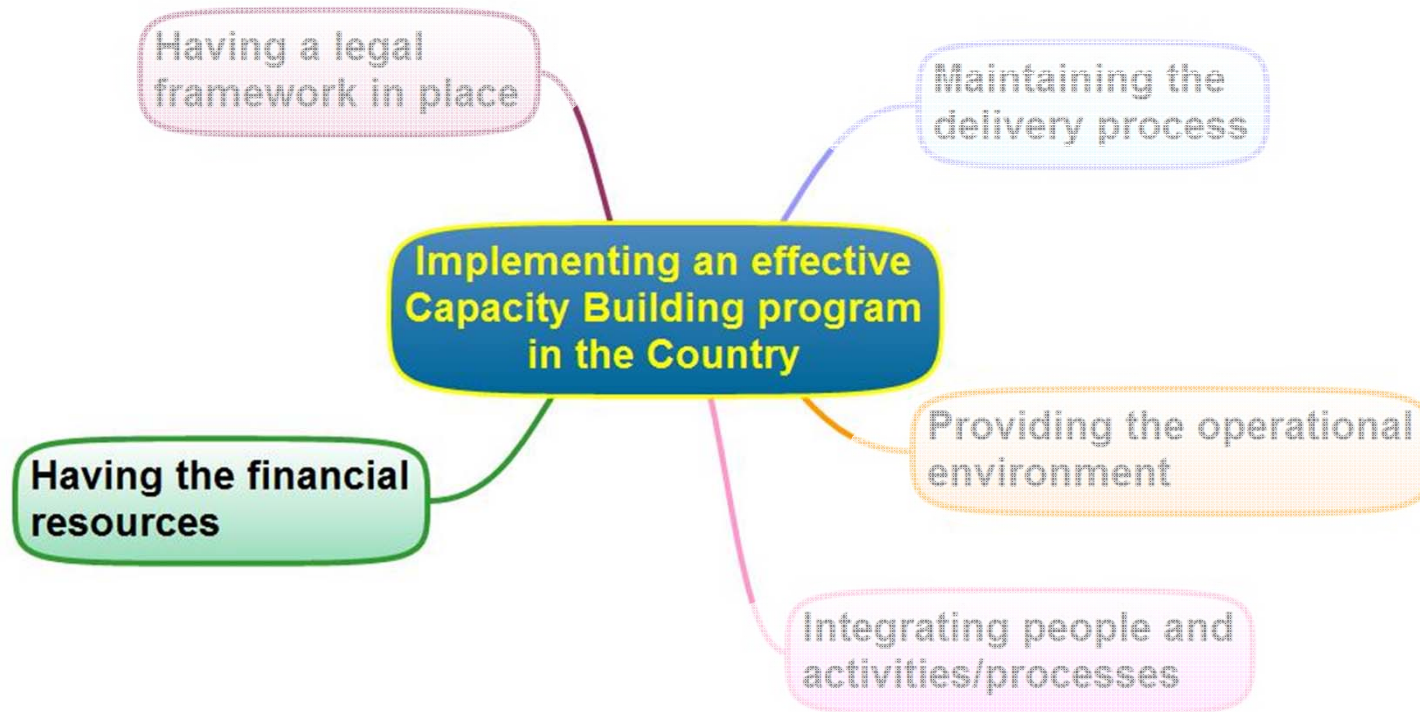
- ▲ Involving of the right and competent people

- ▲ Having the right tools (e.g. IT system, software, equipment)





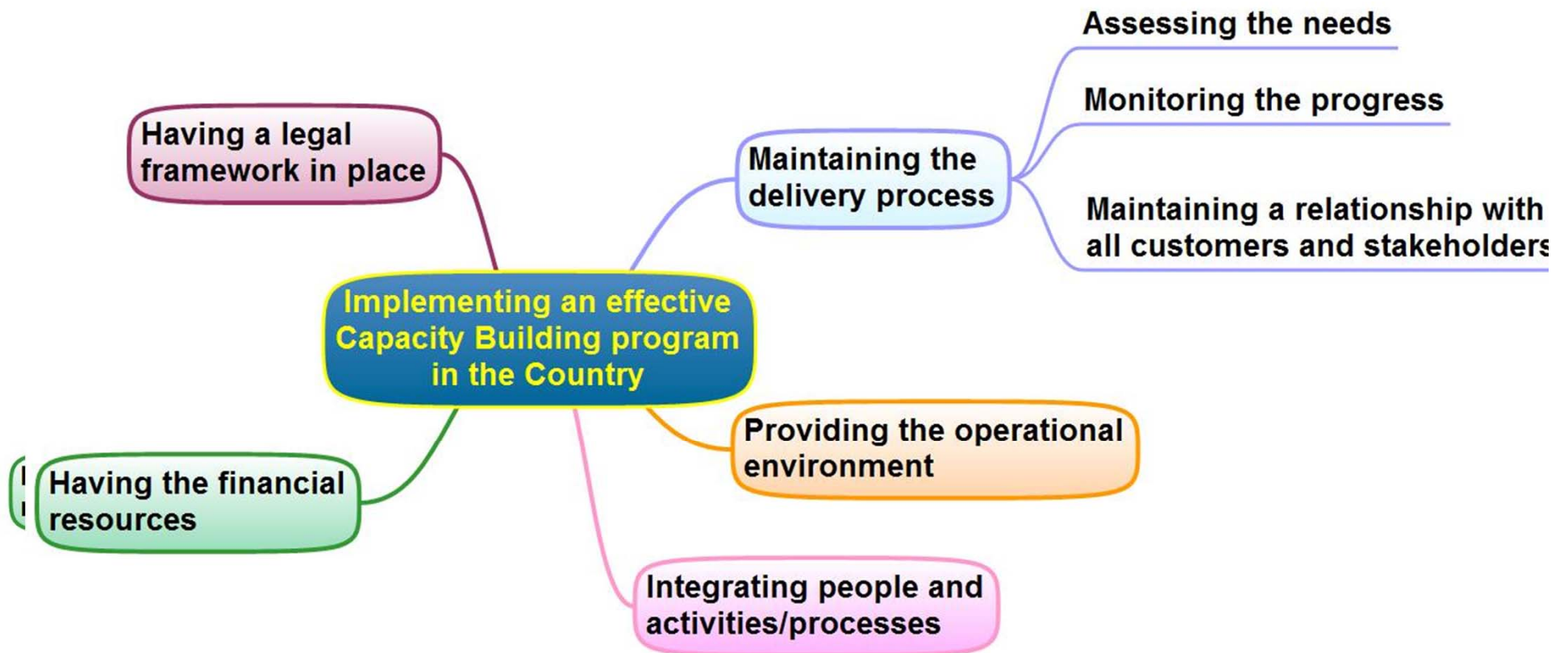
