Highest risk industries or sites and chemicals of concern

Environmental Inspectorate has drafted the first list of the highest risk industries in Albania divided in three main groups:

1. Oil and gas exploration and production companies in Albania

- Albpetrol sh.a,
- Bankers Petroleum Albania L.T.D
- Transatlantic Albania L.T.D
- Sherwood International Petroleum L.T.D
- Petromanas Albania Gmbh
- Phoenix Petroleum sh.a
- Transoil grup sh.a

2. Oil refinery

- Ballsh Oil refinery
- Fier Oil refinery
- 3. Petroleum products stores

Sites in Durrës, Vlora, Shëngjin-Lezhë area.

Most vulnerable issues on SEVESO implementation

Most vulnerable issues on SEVESO implementation are related to:

- Chemical risk assessment;
- industry competence on safety reports preparations;
- Authority low competence on knowledge about:
 - sites identification
 - Evaluation of safety reports
 - preparation and testing the external emergency plans
- Inspectorate competence on control and effective inspection of SEVESO II installations.
- Lack of training programs for matters related to SEVESO II Directive for staff and operators.

Improving performance with SEVESO implementation in the next years

- Establishing the legal framework
- Establishing the institutional framework
- Increasing capacities at national, regional and local level, by training activities in the way to improve the knowledge of competent authorities and industrial operators related to:
 - the establishment of safety objectives,
 - safety standards,
 - guidelines on best practice regarding safety technology,
 - safety reports,
 - safety management systems as well as reporting and inspection regimes

Specific indicators

Specific indicators:

- 1. Establishment of site inventory
- 2. Adoption of draft legal framework:
 - a) draft Law on the Control of Major Industrial Accident Hazards involving dangerous substances that partially transposes Directive 2012/18 / EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 July 2012, within 2017;
 - b) Adoption of 3 by-laws within 1st Q 2018:
 - **Decision on Notifications** under the Law on the Control of Major Industrial Accident Hazards Involving Dangerous Substances
 - Decision on Safety reports and emergency planning,
 - Action plan on implementation of Convention on the Transboundary Effects of Industrial Accidents).
- 3. Establishing an active inspection programme

Specific indicators

- 1. Establishing an training programme for the foreseen competent authorities:
 - ✓ Ministry responsible for the Industry.
 - Ministry responsible for internal affairs;
 - Ministry responsible for health;
 - Ministry responsible for the environment;
 - ✓ Ministry responsible for agriculture;
 - ✓ Ministry responsible for employee safety at work.

related to:

- ✓ Security Reports Assessment;
- Review of documentation;
- Organization of Inspections / legal sanctions;
- ✓ Prohibition of Activity if:
 - Serious deficiencies are presented
 - Irregular or inappropriate documentation
- Preparation and Testing of external emergency plans;
- ✓ Identification of possible Domino effect;
- ✓ The implementation of urban planning policies.
