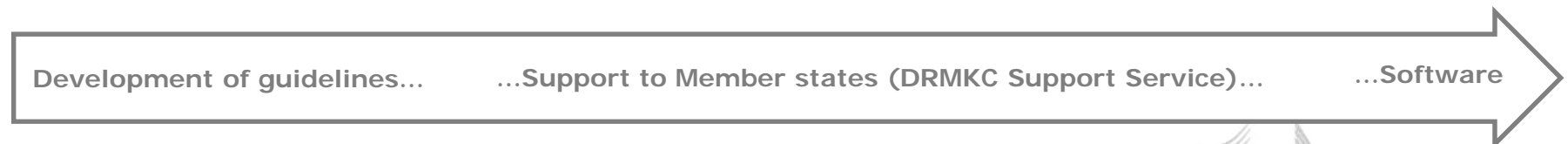

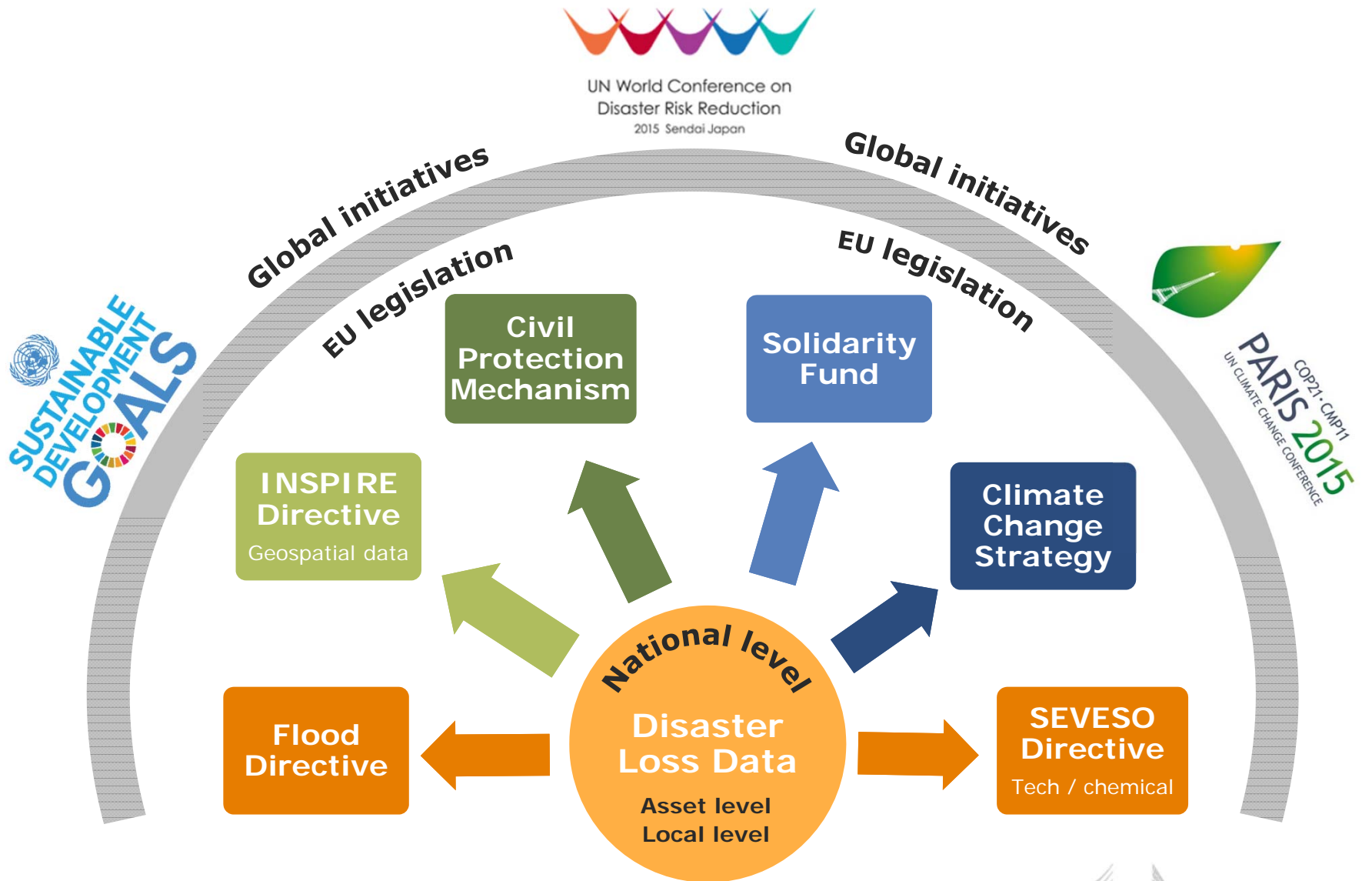

JRC leads an EU process with MS to develop solutions for measuring disaster losses



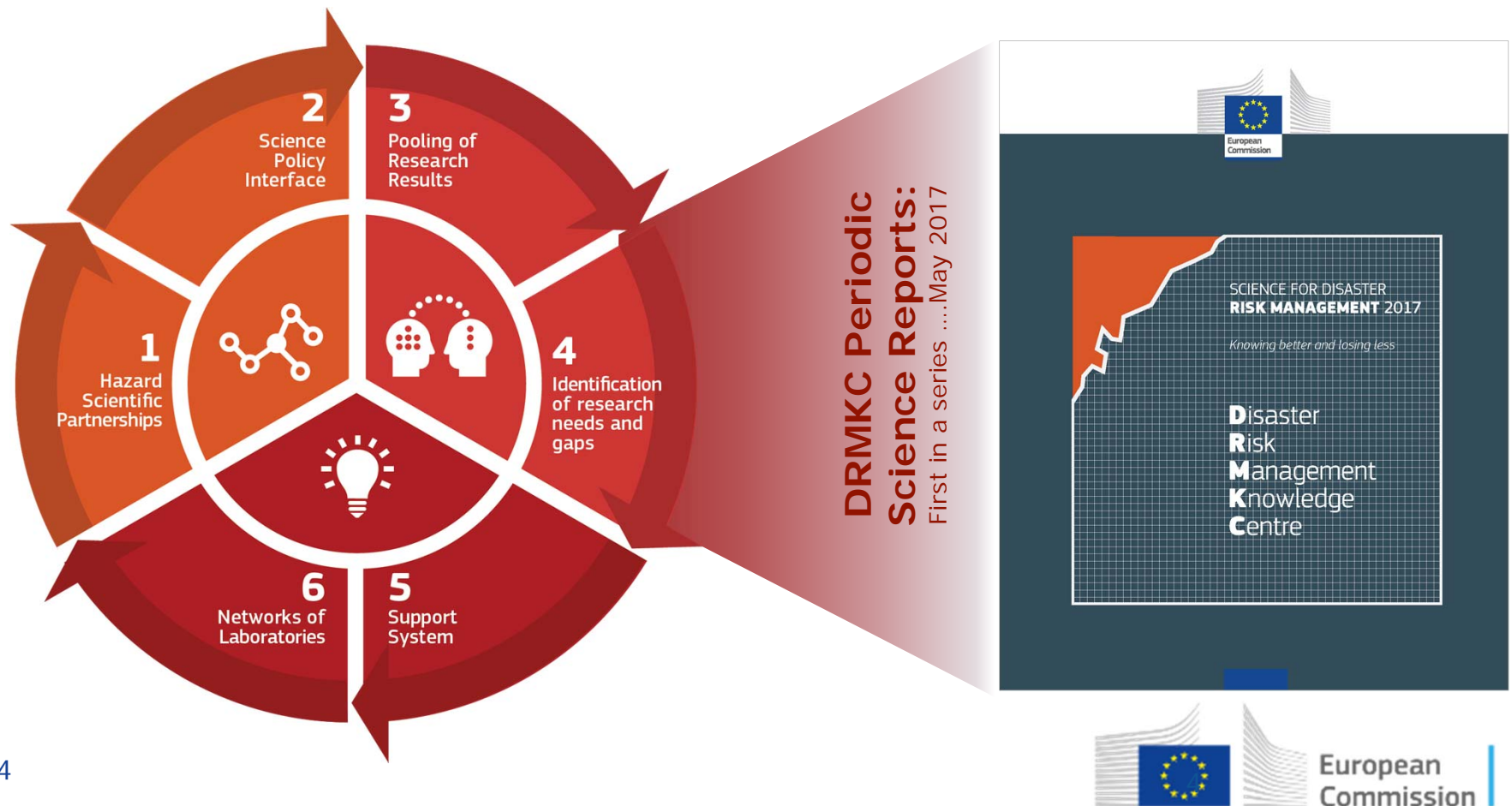

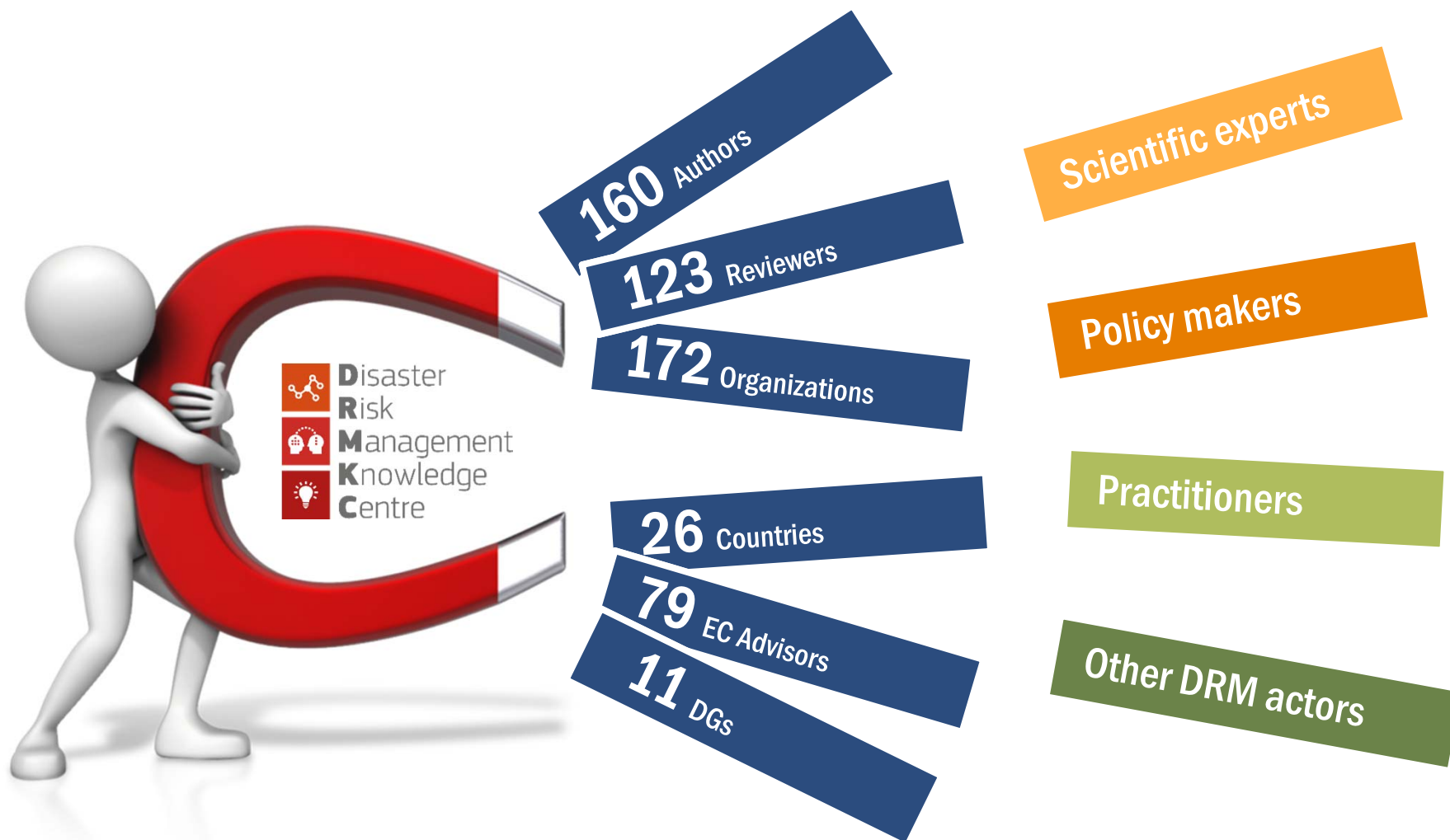

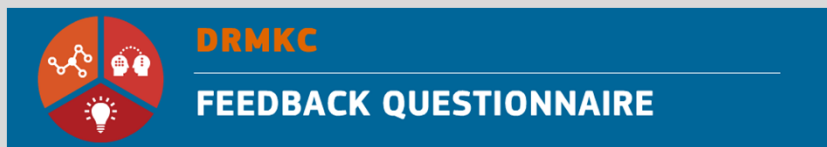
