Evaluating Implementation

Authority

A process followed by the competent authority is described in details in Joint Ministerial Decision No 172058/2016.

• Operator

Information on the public is reviewed by the operator every five (5) years or earlier in the case of an establishment amendment.





Evaluating Implementation

Confidentiality

The operator completes the forms not including confidential information. Confidential information is usually related to industrial know-how, public security, national defence etc.
