Evaluating implementation –

- > **Authority** – All the responsible authorities work together to make sure the information is made available on the same way and amount. The Seveso information is not made publicly available separately. On the digital riskmap the Seveso companies are one of the type of companies where an incidents can occur.
- > **Operator** – The operator does not have any legal obligation to make information available to the public so there is no evaluation of this.
- > **Confidentiality** - Confidentiality is arranged through several legal acts like our General Administrative Law Act. All the information is beside the available with the Provinces and environmental services. If a person or party object to what is confidential and what is publicly available the Province and environmental service has a procedure for this.
